IMPACT OF CAFFEINE CONSUMPTION AMONG GENERAL POPULATION
(MAR 2025- AUG 2025)

This study is conducted with the aim to study the impact of Caffeine Consumption among the General Population. In order to understand the impact of Caffeine Consumption a self-administered questionnaires used to collect information among general population. The whole sample size was 500 general participants. The exclusion criteria were participants with Comorbidities and participants who are not willing. Among 500 samples 240 were males and 260 were female. About 39.8% of participants were addicted to Caffeinated Beverages. 58.6% of participants feels that increased energy level after the intake of Caffeinated Beverages. A significant association (40%) was found between the Amount of Caffeine Consumption and Sleep Cycle Disturbance. If not concerned it increases the risk factor of Insomnia, further leads to mental and physical health issues.
